Dear Pastor and Church

Praise the Lord, winter is finally starting to break. We have had 2 days so far this month that got to "0" C. That's 32F for all you Americans. ☺ But the nights are still dropping down to -20 and -25 (-13F) Average Daytime temp is -10C (+14) So Spring is actually here.

We have been going steadily to Haines and Watson Lake all winter and have seen good results. We have two new ladies at the Watson Lake bible study, Sandra, a middle aged woman and Andrea a 20 year old. Also the couple we have been working with Mike and Shawna Boone are very interested. Mike is especially coming along Great!!! Mike claims salvation but cannot give a clear testimony and up until recently has shown no real interest in the bible study. More often than not he did not even show up. However lately he has been asking a lot of questions and is starting to show some signs of conviction. In fact last week he was called out on a job (he is a tow truck driver) and he told them that they would have to wait until the bible study was over before he could come. **HALLELUJAH**

The work in Haines is also doing very well. We were discouraged last month because one of the key ladies (the one who asked us to come in the first place) had a work schedule change and is no longer able to come to the bible services. We thought about changing the day of the study but decided it would be best to be consistent on our time schedule. Praise the Lord we did. A new family, the Rettingers (Mom, Dad, and three kids) have started coming and it looks like they are very interested. Not sure about their salvation as yet but just having them come out is a good start. We are hoping to set up a Basic Bible Truths class with them in the near future.

Here at home we have seen some of our "wayward, prodigals" come home. Please pray for Steve Ettienne. He is a native fellow that got discouraged a couple of years back when we had some difficulty with a man who came up to "help us" in the work here. "Help Us" he did and we lost about 10 native folks before he left. Steve was one of them. Before the problem Steve was in our Institute, driving a bus and very active. Since he left the church things have gone downhill for him and his family and a couple of weeks back he showed up at church and told me "Pastor I have got to get back to the Lord. My life my family and everything is starting to fall apart." Also a couple of weeks before his return another Inuit lady, Rosey Simon, came back. She has had a real struggle with Alcohol but she told me yesterday that she has been "dry" now for 28 days. Please keep these two native families in your prayers. In addition to the prodigals we have started a Basic Bible Truths class with couple I told you about in my last prayer letter Emma and Gordon. (*Its part of their pre-marriage counseling*) Both claim salvation but there is no fruit. Pray for this couple as well.

Thanks again for all your faithful prayers and support. It is ALL because of Christ but could not happen if it weren't for your faithfulness.
