Furlough—Ministry

We have been extremely busy since our last prayer letter. We have been through Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana, Idaho, Washington—all in September. In October we were in meetings in California everyday but four. God has blessed in a great way by providing the needed support for the new radio station for the Pygmies.

We have also seen God work in the lives of many people throughout our journeys—some in rededication of their lives and in their giving.

God answered my prayers by allowing me the honor to preach to the men of both Golden State College and West Coast Baptist College. The Lord moved in a mighty, way calling several students to fulltime missionary service and especially to the harvest fields of Africa.

Uganda Ministry Continues

The church, institute, radio and village ministries continue to go well while we are here on furlough. Many of our people have stepped up and taken responsibility in our absence.

We are really making a breakthrough with the radio. In the last few months they have reported 161 souls that have come to Christ. They are receiving several calls each day about salvation.

The new believers have been gathered into groups in several villages. Pastor Robert has been going to each village discipling the converts. He is doing as much as he possibly can. He wrote and said, "Pastor, we need laborers. They are coming for church but there is no one to teach them." Please pray for laborers for the harvest.

The orphanage building continues to go up and is up to the second floor. We are getting very excited to see what God is going to allow us to do through project HOPE. Help us give them HOPE.

Prayer Support

While we were in a conference in California I received one of the greatest blessings outside of salvation. A wonderful lady named Elva, came up to me thanking us for



our work. She then told me that she remembered the first time we came to the church 15 years ago. She told me that she had prayed for us every day for the last 15 years.
